- The mini-split HVAC unit will be set at 68 in the cooler months and 72 in the warmer months.

 If adjustments are needed, the hand-held controller is located on the south wall near the wash sink.
 - Paper towels, toilet paper, basic cleaning supplies, and trash bags will be fully-stocked.

 Paper towels are under the wash sink, and extra toilet paper will be kept in the bathroom cabinet. All basic cleaning supplies and trash bags are provided in the locker nearest the wash sink.
 - A toilet plunger is located below the toilet tank in the bathroom. For plumbing emergencies, please contact the numbers provided.
